



## Hindu Wedding Jewellery

Jewellery forms a very important part of what an Indian bride wears on her wedding day.

Precious stones, such as ruby, jade, garnet, emerald, amethyst and pearl, are widely used in Indian bridal jewellery. In the majority of Indian weddings, you will find the bride wearing yellow gold jewellery - like the set we have here.

In this set we have the following:

**Maang Tikka** - comprises of a gold chain with a jewelled centre piece attached to one end and a hook to the other. It is worn by the bride in centre parting of the hair.

**Bridal Set (Necklace & Earrings)** - the outfit of a bride is incomplete without the bridal set, which comprises of a heavy neck piece, along with matching earrings. It is usually selected keeping in mind the colour and overall style of the bridal dress.
