



Rehel Quran Stand

Rehel are wooden Quran holders that are traditionally used when studying, reading, or memorising the Quran.

Most Muslims believe that only those who are physically clean through formal ablutions should touch the pages of the Quran. As a result of this general understanding, the following "rules" are usually followed when handling the Quran:

1. One should make formal ablutions before handling the Quran
2. One who is in need of a formal bath should not touch the Quran until after bathing
3. A non-Muslim should not handle the sacred text, but may listen to tapes of the Quran or handle a translation or exegesis.
4. Those who are unable to handle the Quran based on these reasons should either avoid handling the Quran completely or hold it by using some sort of barrier such as a cloth or a glove or Rehel like this one.
